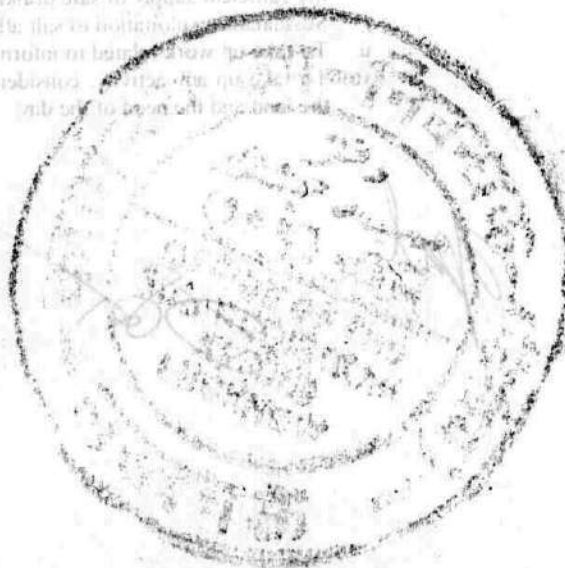

MEETINGS: -

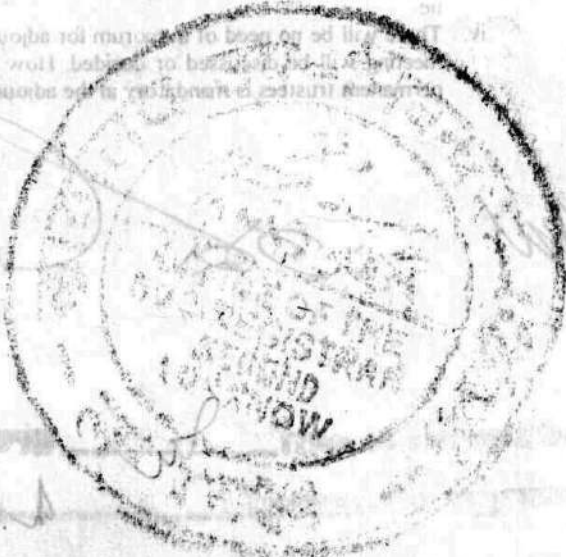

DISQUALIFICATION OF THE TRUSTEE

- i. A trustee shall cease to be a Trustee of the trust if a competent authority court in respect of heinous crime convicts him.
- ii. Is declared insane/insolvent by a competent authority.
- iii. If he misappropriate, misuses, fails or refuses to account for the property of the trust under his care, casting the shadow on his integrity and honesty in the estimation of the chairman.
- iv. Held by the chairman to be involved directly or indirectly in the activities bringing bad name to the trust.

The chairman may terminate the trustee ship of such person without assigning any reason thereof.

POWERS, DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS:

CHAIRMAN

- a. The Chairman shall preside over all the meetings of the General Body.

CIVIL SUITS

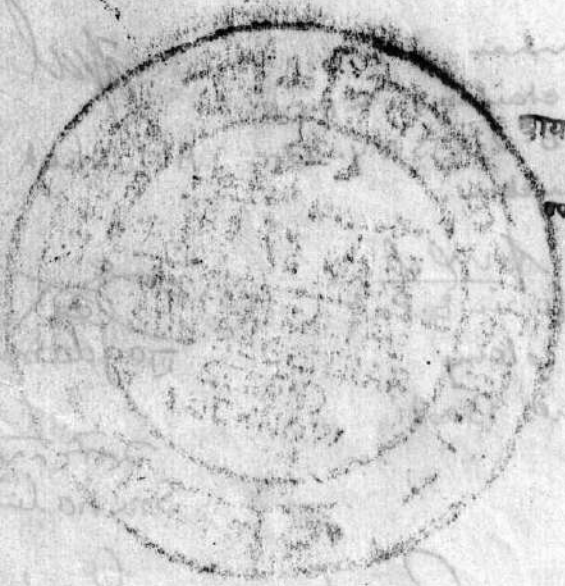
The trust shall be sued under name of the trustees.
